

<p>Objective/s : The objective of this questionnaire is to elicit your frank opinion and perceptions regarding the overall experience, planning and quality assessment of the training session organized by the institutes in collaboration with Critical Care Unit, SKH.</p>
<p>Brief report summary on the Activity :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This Feedback form provide insights on various aspects such as overall experience, organization of an event, Effectiveness of Hands-on training and feedback of the training team include engagement of facilitators and topics covered by the team. The questionnaire was formulated as Google Form and was circulated in institutional students' group.
<p>Summary of the Feedback: The feedback form contained 5 basic questions with responses from a group of 81 students. The feedback evaluates overall experience, organization of an event, Effectiveness of Hands-on training and assessment of delivering relevant content, speaker clarity and topic coverage.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Overall Experience: The majority of participants rated their overall experience as excellent, indicating a high level of satisfaction with the training. A notable portion of attendees found the session good, while a small fraction rated it as average. There were no negative ratings, suggesting that the session met or exceeded expectations for most attendees. Organization of the Training: The organization of the training received high praise, with most respondents rating it as excellent. A significant number also found it good, highlighting a well-structured and efficiently managed session. Only a minimal percentage rated it as average, suggesting that improvements could be made in logistical aspects such as scheduling, coordination, or resource availability. Relevance of Topics Covered: Participants largely agreed that the topics covered were relevant and useful. A strong majority strongly agreed with this statement, while others simply agreed. A very small number remained neutral, indicating that the session successfully addressed key learning objectives and was aligned with participants' expectations. Effectiveness of Hands-on Activities: Hands-on activities were well-received, with most attendees strongly agreeing that they were effective in understanding the concepts. Some participants agreed with this statement, while only a small number

remained neutral. This feedback suggests that practical demonstrations were engaging and contributed significantly to learning, but there may be opportunities to enhance the experience further.


5. **Facilitators' approach:** The facilitators were recognized for their knowledge, preparedness, and ability to engage participants effectively. The majority of attendees strongly agreed that facilitators performed well, while others agreed. A small percentage remained neutral, and a very minor fraction expressed dissatisfaction. This indicates that while the facilitators were largely effective, there could be improvements in making the sessions even more interactive or addressing diverse learning styles.
6. **Additional Comments & Suggestions:** Most participants did not provide additional comments, but a few mentioned that the session was good. The absence of extensive feedback may suggest overall satisfaction, but it also presents an opportunity to actively seek suggestions for further refinement in future sessions.

The feedback indicates that the BLS training was highly effective in delivering relevant content, engaging participants, and providing practical learning experiences. The facilitators were well-received, and the organizational aspects of the session were well-managed.
